

The revised Vermont Fire and Building Safety Code requires all fuel fired heating appliances in public buildings to be inspected at least every 2 years by a certified heating fuel technician.

According to the Vermont fire code (effective 6/15/09), at the time of inspection "the appliance shall be marked with the date of the inspection and the name and certificate number of the technician who performed the inspection." VFDA has confirmed that this can be part of your company's inspection tag or a separate tag. VFDA has created a separate inspection tag that is in compliance with the fire code.
