The course taught by Bob Hedden is an updated and condensed version of the NEFI 160 hour course. It is based upon the National Oilheat Research Alliance (NORA) Technicians Manual. Bob is the editor of the NORA manual and the Education Director for NORA. The NORA Bronze Test will be given on the last day of the course and a NORA Bronze Certificate of Training will be awarded to each student who completes the course and passes the examination.
