

## **COMMERCIAL VEHICLE ENFORCEMENT UNIT (1/31-2/6)**

### **NORTHWEST SECTOR:**

#### **Details:**

- **2/1 Leicester, US Rte 7, 2 Inspectors screened 89 vehicles. They completed 12 inspections which resulted in four vehicle violations.**
- **2/4 Georgia SB, I-89, 6 Inspectors screened 179 vehicles. They completed 30 inspections which resulted in 28 vehicle and 9 driver violations. Three vehicles were placed out of service.**
- **2/5 Ferrisburgh, US Rte 7, 3 Inspectors screened 85 vehicles. They completed 21 inspections which resulted in 15 vehicle violations. One vehicle was placed out of service.**



- **2/5 Cambridge, VT Rte 104, 3 Inspectors screened 22 vehicles. They completed 11 inspections which resulted in 4 vehicle and 3 driver violations. One driver was placed out of service.**

#### **Crashes:**

- **2/1 Inspector responded to a report of a dump truck crash on VT Rte. 2A in Colchester. Upon arrival, it was determined a passenger car crashed into the side of the dump truck as the truck was backing into a job site. The driver of the passenger car reported being blinded by the sun and did not see the truck in**

**the roadway. Both vehicles sustained disabling damage and were towed from the scene. The dump truck was placed out of service.**



**Notables:**

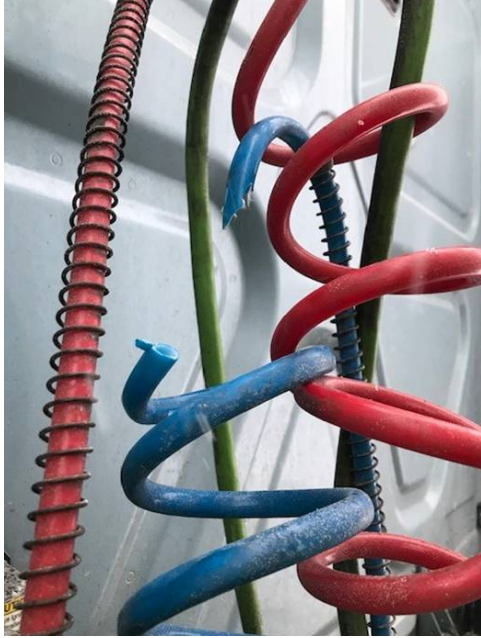
- **2/2 Inspectors assisted other state, local, and county agencies with several weather related incidents throughout the NW sector.**

**Passenger Carrier:**

- **Nothing to report.**

**Notables:**

- **2/5 Inspector inspected a tractor trailer at the Ferrisburgh detail. The CMV was placed out of service for a severed service glad hand hose. This resulted in the trailer having no operable brakes and the truck tractor failing the air loss test.**



### **NORTHEAST SECTOR:**

#### **Details:**

- **2/3 Ryegate, I-91 NB Rest Area. Four Inspectors screened 89 vehicles. Eleven inspections were completed. Two vehicle violations were discovered.**
- **2/4 Waterford Welcome Center, I-93 NB. Three screened 101 vehicles. Eight inspections were completed. Seven vehicle (one out of service) and one driver violations were discovered.**

#### **Crashes:**

- **2/2 Newport Center, VT Rte 100. Inspectors responded to assist VSP-Derby at a CMV versus passenger vehicle. Two occupants were transported for injuries. Reports were that the passenger vehicle crossed the centerline and struck the CMV head on while attempting to pass a plow truck. The CMV (GVWR of 19,500 lbs operating in intrastate commerce) did not meet the applicability for a CMV Level 1 inspection. A Level 7 inspection was completed. No pre-existing defects were discovered.**



**Notables:**

- **2/1 Two Inspectors started an early morning shift in response to heavy log and chip trucks operation before daylight on the US Rte 2 corridor in Essex County. One CMV transporting wood chips was stopped in Lunenburg and weighed. The CMV weighed 121,000 lbs. A Level 2 inspection was completed, a ticket was issued to the company and the CMV was grounded.**



- **2/3 Ryegate detail. A Level 2 inspection was completed on this six axle CMV transporting logs. The CMV was found to weigh 115,200 lbs. A ticket was issued to the carrier.**



- **2/3 Ryegate detail. A Level 2 inspection was completed on this six axle CMV transporting logs. The CMV was found to weigh 108,500. A ticket was issued to the carrier.**



- **2/2 Irasburg, VT Rte 14. While on patrol, an Inspector came across a two-vehicle crash with injury. The Inspector stabilized one of the occupants, who had suffered a compound leg fracture, and then assisted with extrication once EMS arrived on scene.**



- **2/5 Brighton, VT Rte 105. Inspectors responded to Brighton for a report of a five axle CMV on the side of the roadway with the operator slumped over in the driver's seat. The Inspectors contacted the driver, who was sleeping. A Level 3 inspection was completed and the driver was placed out of service for a false log.**



**New Entrant:**

- **Five carriers contacted regarding audit, document uploads, inactivation, or closeout. Three audits completed. 14.75 hours**

**Passenger Vehicles:**

- **No activity reported.**

**SOUTH SECTOR:**

**Details:**

- **White River Jct, I-91S, Inspectors screened 173 vehicles. They completed 10 inspections resulting in 2 vehicle violations.**



- **2/4 Putney, I-91S, Inspectors screened and weighed 100 vehicles. They completed 10 inspections resulting in 2 vehicle violations.**



**Notables:**

- **2/1 Inspectors patrolled VT Rte 11, 100 and 30 in Chester, Londonderry, Jamaica area and VT Rte 9, I91 and US Rte 5 in Brattleboro, Marlboro, and Dummerston.**
- **2/3 Inspector came across a single vehicle that went off the road and was stuck in the median on I89 in the Town of Hartford.**



- **2/4 Inspector discovered a leaking discharge valve on a milk tanker at the Putney Scale House. The leak was stopped, and the vehicle continued the trip.**
